The objective of mammography is to detect cancer. Sometimes abnormalities are detected which are not clearly benign or malignant. If you have had a previous exam this issue can be frequently resolved without additional films or biopsy. Additionally, a very subtle abnormality may become apparent if compared with previous films, such change may suggest cancer. It is therefore extremely important that you bring your old exam with you at the time of your mammogram for comparison. If your films are not here at the time of your mammogram, your physician will receive a preliminary report until a comparison can be made.
